→ summary of main events (setting, plot, characters) without revealing the ending!	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• setting: Arnold lives on an Indian reservation in Washington, USA. He attends an official high school in Washington.</li> <li>• plot: The book “The Absolutely True Diary of a Part-Time Indian” is about fourteen-year-old Arnold, who lives on an Indian reservation in Washington. One day he decides to change his life and decides to attend an official high school outside his reservation. The book tells us which experiences he gains there.</li> <li>• characters: The main character, Arnold, is an Indian guy. He is an Indian who is not very popular at the reservation and later at school. Because of his looks he is bullied. The consequence is that he does not have self-confidence but many self-doubts.</li> </ul>

<p>→ language</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• level (easy – difficult, why?) The level is easy because the author uses words which are easy to understand and makes the sentences easy.</li> <li>• style (interesting – boring, why?) It is interesting because there are some comics in the book.</li> </ul>
<p>→ form</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• page numbers: 236</li> <li>• price: 7- 8€</li> <li>• annotations: vocabulary help</li> </ul>
<p>→ comment</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• We like about the book: the crazy things about Arnold</li> <li>• We dislike about the book: It is a typical book with people who have problems with themselves. That is boring.</li> <li>• Recommendation (yes – no, why?): We would not read the book because it is too typical and normal.</li> </ul>
