→ author, title, year of publication	<p>John Green Looking for Alaska 2005</p>
→ summary of main events (setting, plot, characters) without revealing the ending!	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • setting: Florida, Miles' home → Alabama Boarding School – plot: Miles moves from Florida to boarding school in Alabama (no friends in Florida) meets Alaska, falls in love. Alaska dies because of unknown reasons, Miles and his new friends try to get to know why this happened • characters: Miles Halter, Alaska Young, Chip Martin, Takumi Hikohito, Lara Buterskaya
→ themes (e. g. friendship, conflict with parents)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • “conflicts” with parents, “old” life with no friends, etc. • “new” life at boarding school in Alabama with new friends • friendship • love • desire • taking over responsibility
→ prediction of the content of the novel	<p>Miles gets the chance to change his whole life and finds out, why his big love Alaska died.</p>

→ language	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • level (easy – difficult, why?) not too difficult vocabulary on the bottom of every page • style (interesting – boring, why?) less interesting → no special way of writing, too typical
→ form	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • page numbers: 221 • price: 11,90€ • annotations: vocabulary lists
→ comment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • We like about the book: Parts of the story (realistic) • We dislike about the book: way of writing story → in general • Recommendation (yes – no, why?): No → themes too typical, boring
