→ author, title, year of publication	<p><b>Mark Haddon</b>  <b>The Curious Incident of the Dog in the Night-Time</b>  <b>2004</b> (first published in 2003)</p>
→ summary of main events (setting, plot, characters) without revealing the ending!	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• setting: changes between the neighbor's garden and another place with a person called Siobhan</li> <li>• plot: the 15-year-old teen Christopher John Francis Boone finds the dead dog of his neighbor Mrs. Shears killed with a garden fork in their garden. She suspects Christopher of having killed her dog</li> <li>• characters: Christopher John Francis Boone                      police officer                      the neighbors (Mrs. Shears)                      Siobhan (Christopher's social worker)</li> </ul>
→ themes (e. g. friendship, conflict with parents)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• finds the dog in the garden</li> <li>• conflict between the neighbor and police officer</li> <li>• talking with Siobhan about feelings</li> <li>• talking about writing a book</li> </ul>
→ prediction of the content of the novel	<p>The real murderer of the dog will never be found. Christopher leaves his school and drives to foreign countries in order to study towards his A-level exam in math.</p>

<p>→ language</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• level (easy – difficult, why?) It is easy to read because you can understand the important facts.</li> <li>• style (interesting – boring, why?) Interesting because the plot is very exciting.</li> </ul>
<p>→ form</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• page numbers: 259</li> <li>• price: 7.40 € / 10.17 \$</li> <li>• annotations: the story deals with suspense</li> <li>• you want to know the end of the story</li> </ul>
<p>→ comment</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• We like about the book: We liked the suspense in the story</li> <li>• We dislike about the book:</li> <li>• Recommendation (yes – no, why?): Yes, because it is written in a very interesting way and you want to know who killed the dog</li> </ul>
